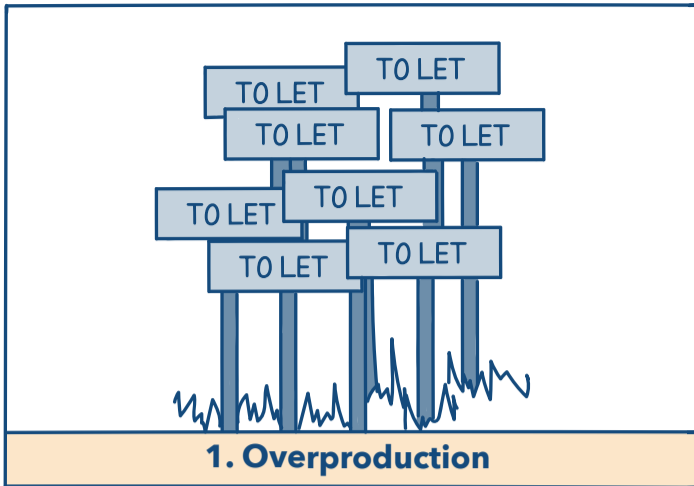


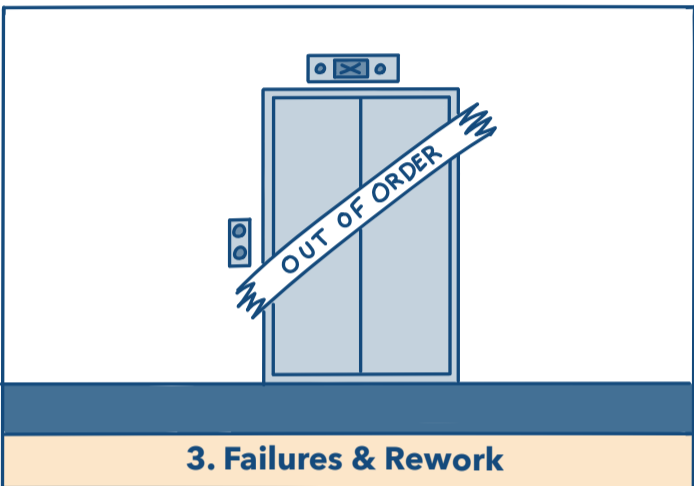
7 Wastes - Housing Examples



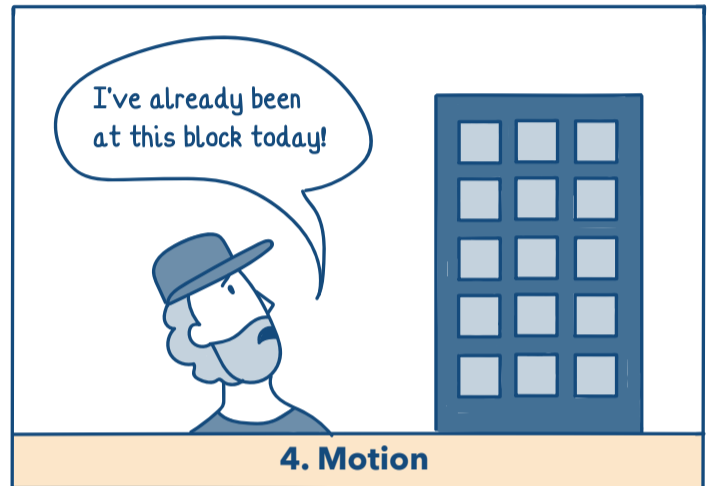
Constructing or renovating more social housing units than what is needed at a given time.



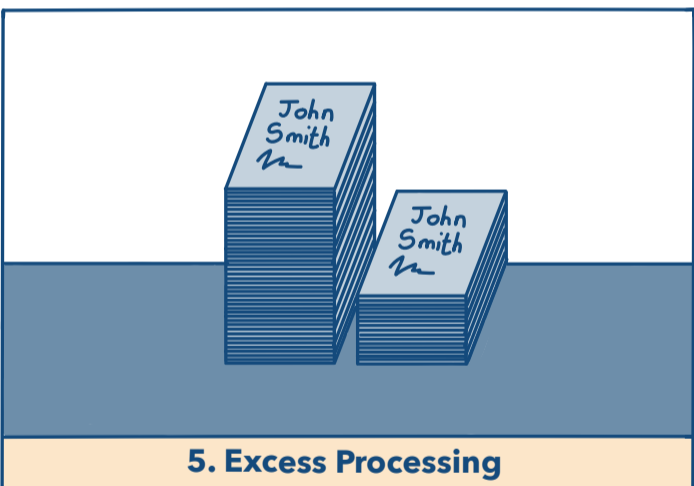
Delays in the multi-step allocation process, where individuals or families have to wait for housing.



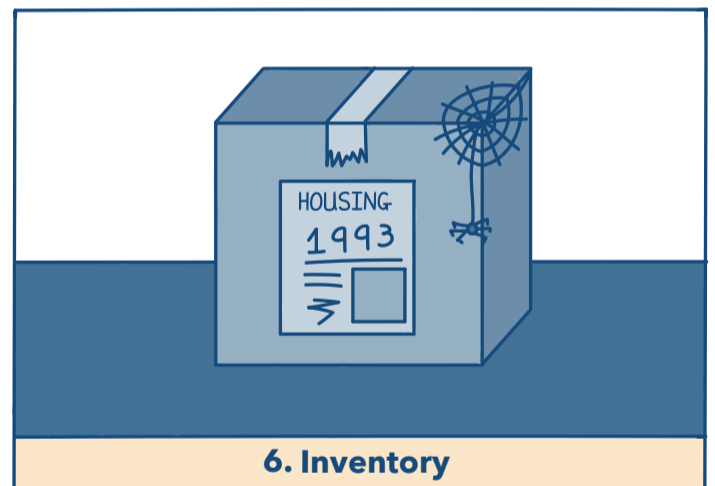
Poorly constructed or maintained social housing units that require frequent repairs or rework.



Housing operatives travelling long or unnecessary distances to make repairs.



Recording redundant forms or duplicating data entry.



Accumulating too many maintenance supplies or materials that aren't required.



Multiple trips to transport one jobs worth of paint (or other materials).

7 Wastes

Waste is anything that does NOT add value to your product or service. Every activity in your organisation either adds customer value, or cost (Waste). Reducing waste allows your team to spend more time on meeting customer requirements.
